WMed faculty embrace the advantages that digital media provides and have selected Vital Source as the online digital textbook provider for our students. Vital Source permits course instructors to highlight and annotate the digital text and allows both faculty and students to share notes – all as a means of fostering collaborative learning. Most, but not all, necessary texts are available on Vital Source.

The medical school has negotiated, on your behalf, an online subscription to both year 1 and year 2 textbooks for a duration of three-years. As part of the purchasing agreement, students will be able to print and download their textbooks for off-line and perpetual use. Thus, students *should not* individually purchase required Vital Source textbooks. Instead, all students will pay an amortized yearly amount invoiced by the medical school for the purchase of required Vital Source textbooks prior to the start of the academic year. Many of these textbooks will be used in both year 1 and year 2, and to successfully prepare and sit for the USMLE Step 1 exam.
